Primary Colors = Red, Yellow, Blue

Secondary Colors = Orange, Green, Purple

Warm Colors = Red, Orange, Yellow

Cool Colors =
Blue, Purple, Green

## Landscapes *plus* our Color Ideas!

1. On a blank sheet of paper, draw a LANDSCAPE - Sky and Ground. a. Could be: Forest, Beach, Mountains, Farm, etc...
2. In the Sky, only color in with WARM COLORS: Reds, Yellows, Oranges a. Use whatever art supplies you have - pens, crayons, markers, etc..
3. On the Ground, only color in with COOL COLORS: Blues, Purples, Greens a. Use whatever art supplies you have - pens, crayons, markers, etc...

## 1. How Mrs. Schwartz drew her Landscape

She drew big. Had a sky and a ground. And went to the edges of her paper.


## 2. Use WARM Colors, to color in your SKY.

Your sky does not have to look like Real Life! Just use all the Warm Colors that you have!


## 3. Use COOL Colors to color in your GROUND.

Your ground does not have to look like Real Life - just use all of the Cool Colors that you have!
