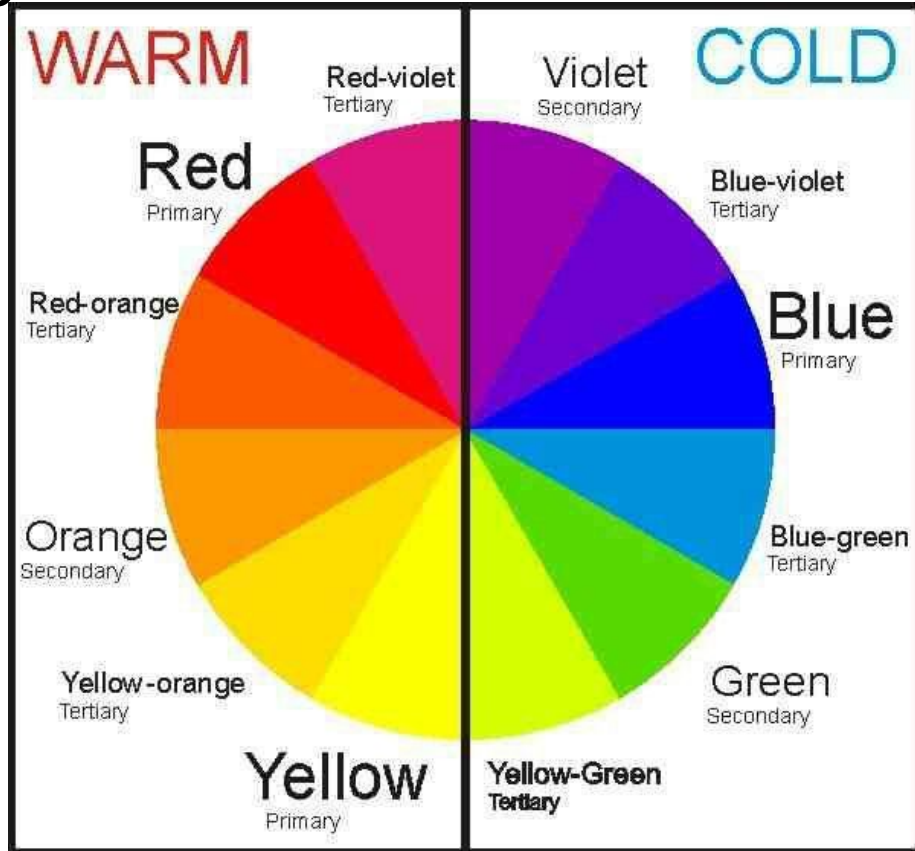
# Reviewing our 2nd grade Color Ideas:

**Primary Colors** =  
Red, Yellow, Blue

**Secondary Colors** =  
Orange, Green, Purple

**Warm Colors** =  
Red, Orange, Yellow

**Cool Colors** =  
Blue, Purple, Green

# Connection Time!

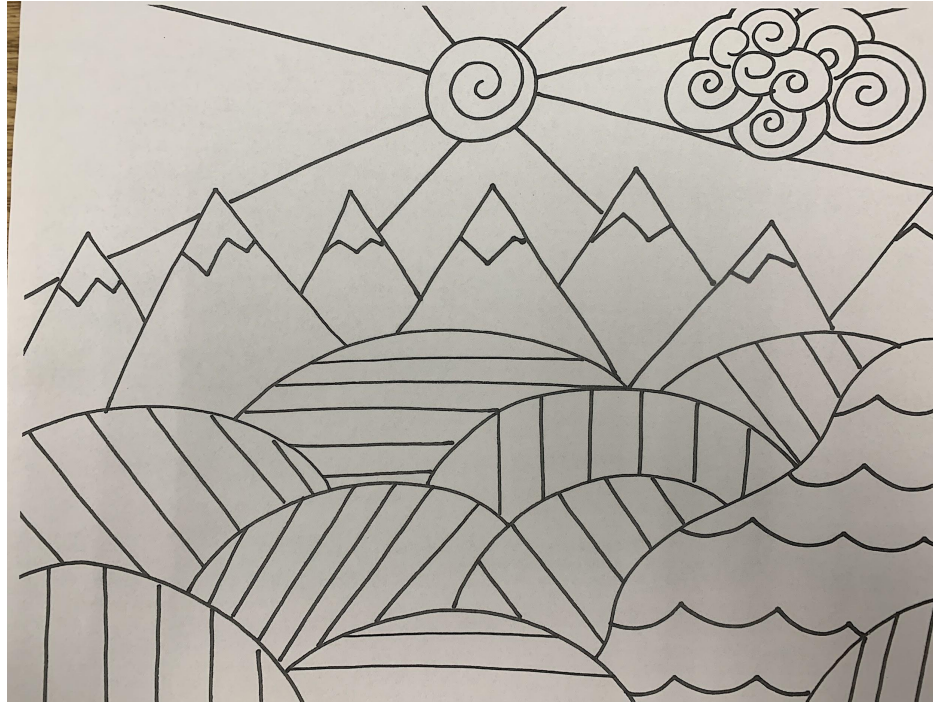
**Landscapes** \*plus\* our **Color** Ideas!

1. On a blank sheet of paper, draw a LANDSCAPE - Sky and Ground.
  - a. Could be: Forest, Beach, Mountains, Farm, etc...
2. In the Sky, only color in with WARM COLORS: Reds, Yellows, Oranges
  - a. Use whatever art supplies you have - pens, crayons, markers, etc...
3. On the Ground, only color in with COOL COLORS: Blues, Purples, Greens
  - a. Use whatever art supplies you have - pens, crayons, markers, etc...

# 1. How Mrs. Schwartz drew her Landscape

She drew big. Had a sky and a ground. And went to the edges of her paper.





## 2. Use WARM Colors, to color in your SKY.

Your sky does not have  
to look like Real Life!  
Just use all the  
Warm Colors that you  
have!



### 3. Use COOL Colors to color in your GROUND.

Your ground does not have to look like Real Life - just use all of the Cool Colors that you have!
