
Reviewing our 2nd grade Color Ideas:

Primary Colors = Red, Yellow, Blue

Secondary Colors = Orange, Green, Purple

Warm Colors = Red, Orange, Yellow

Cool Colors = Blue, Purple, Green



#### **Connection Time!**


#### Landscapes \*plus\* our Color Ideas!

- 1. On a blank sheet of paper, draw a LANDSCAPE Sky and Ground.
  - a. Could be: Forest, Beach, Mountains, Farm, etc...
- 2. In the Sky, only color in with WARM COLORS: Reds, Yellows, Oranges
  - a. Use whatever art supplies you have pens, crayons, markers, etc...
- 3. On the Ground, only color in with COOL COLORS: Blues, Purples, Greens
  - a. Use whatever art supplies you have pens, crayons, markers, etc...

She drew big. Had a sky and a ground. And went to the edges of her paper.




## 2. Use WARM Colors, to color in your SKY.

Just use all the
Warm Colors that you have!



3. Use COOL Colors to color in your GROUND.

Your ground does not have to look like Real Life - just use all of the Cool Colors that you have!
