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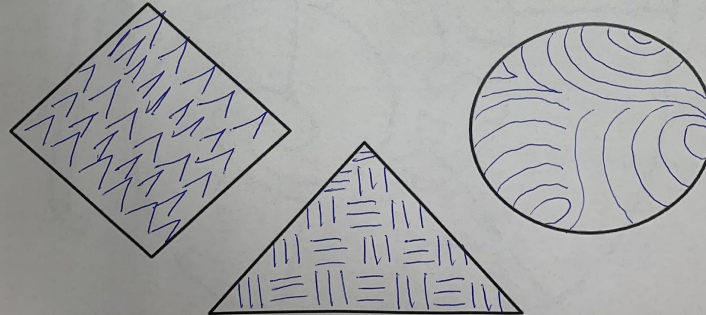
The Teacher's Example:

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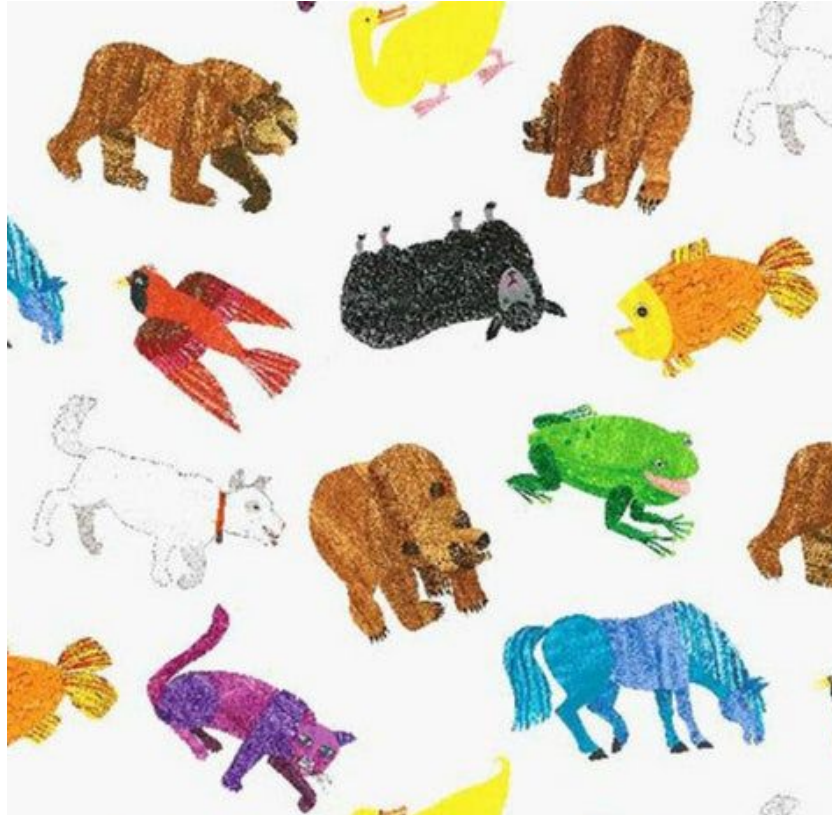


Artist and author **Eric Carle** uses **Visual Texture**:

And so many more!

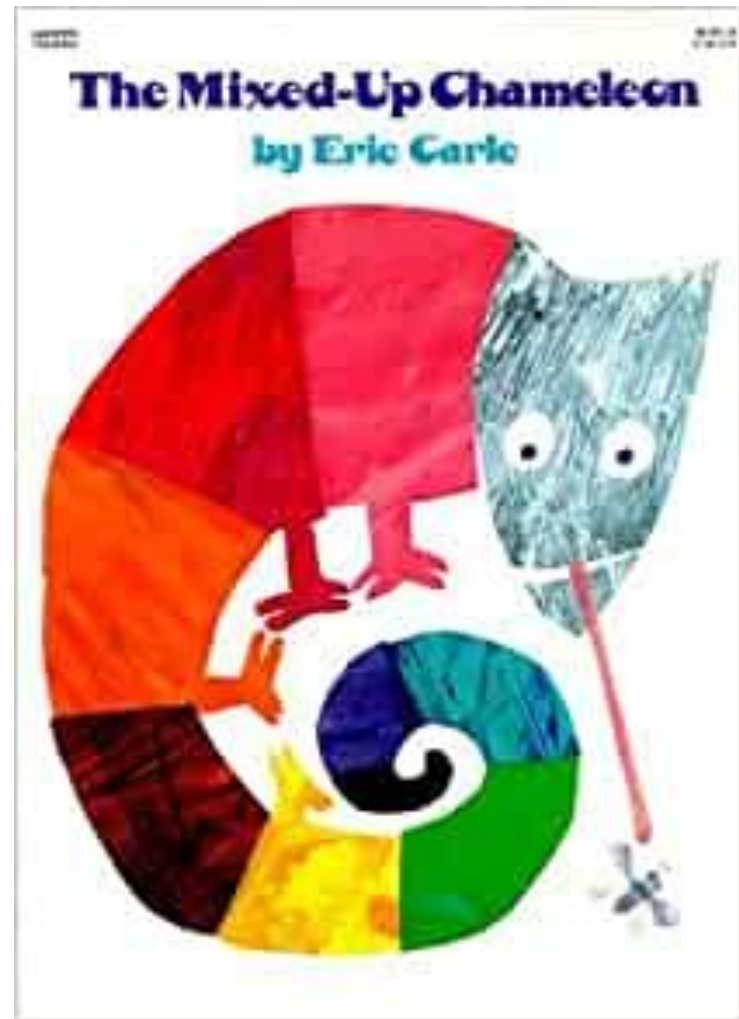

5 items that you can only SEE their Texture, but not FEEL

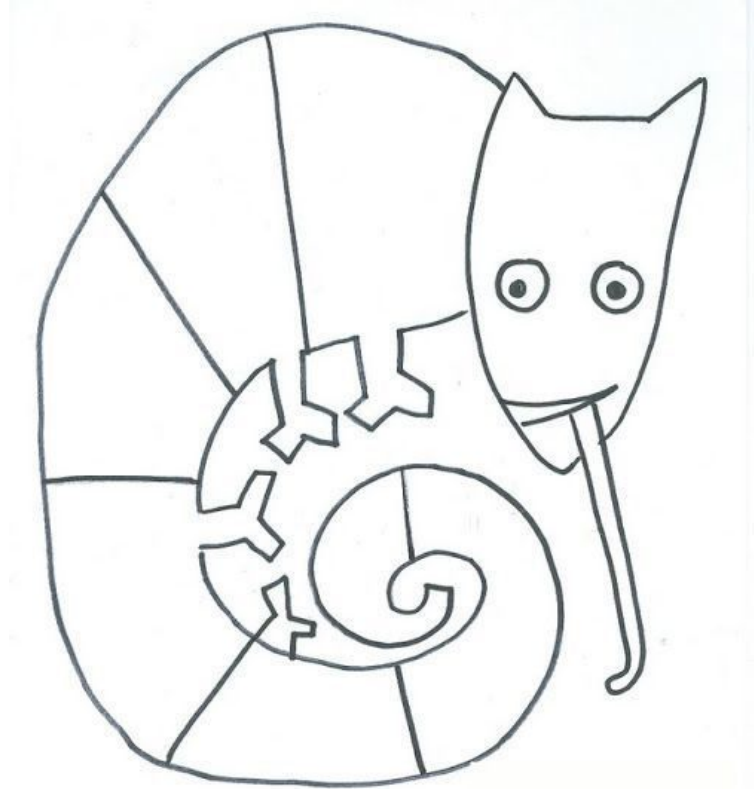
Apply **Visual Texture** to our Mixed-Up Chameleon!

Using crayons and your list of Visual Textures, fill in the blank pieces.

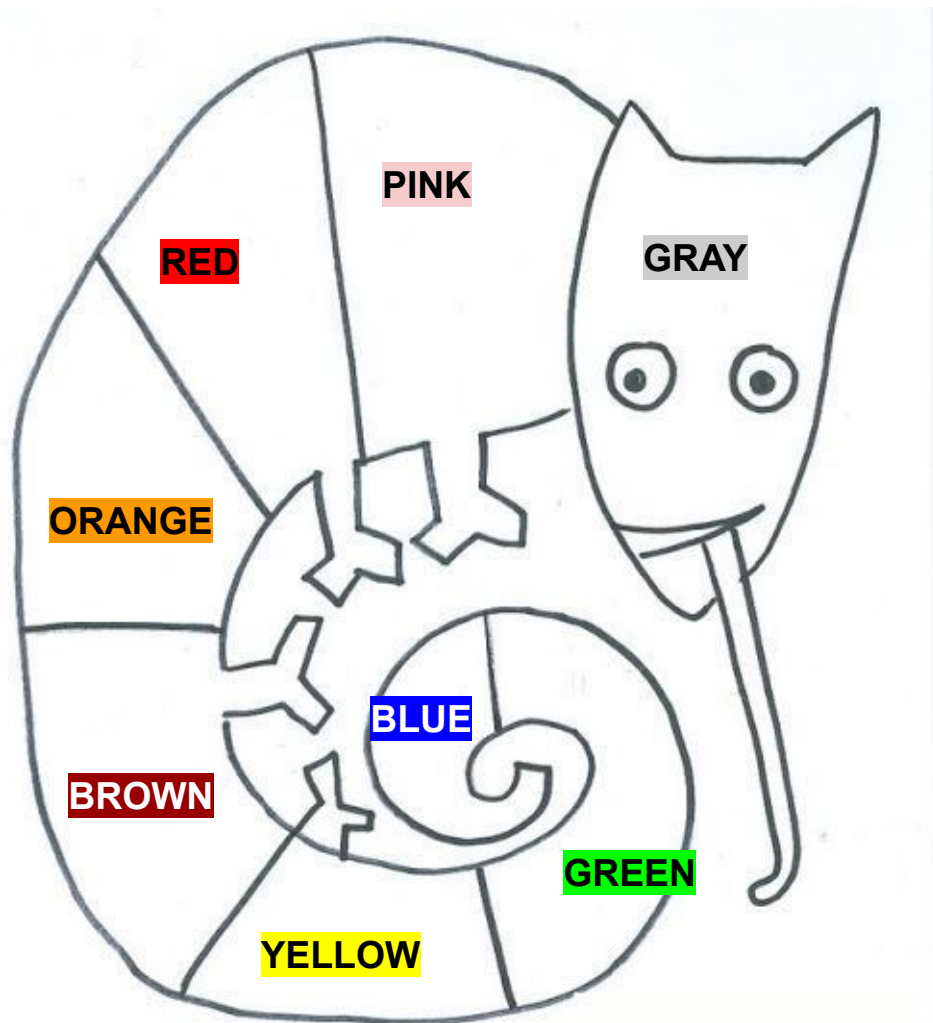
Each piece has its own special color.
